

Eastman Computer Science Merit Scholarship

1. The scholarship will be for \$4,000 payable in installments of \$1,000/semester for four semesters to be used for tuition and fees during the junior and senior year.
2. Scholars will be selected in the second semester of their sophomore year or during their junior year.
3. The scholarship will be renewable for four semesters provided the scholars maintain minimal cumulative GPA requirements and maintain full-time student status for each term paid by the scholarship.
4. Scholars may work for other businesses while holding this scholarship. A scholar cannot simultaneously hold an Eastman scholarship and a scholarship sponsored by a direct competitor of Eastman.
5. Scholar candidates will be selected by the Department of Computer Science. They will be interviewed by the Eastman Representative responsible for college relations at the school. The college should present a minimum of 3 candidates for the scholarship (suggested). Students must be majoring in Computer Science, Industrial Engineering, Information Systems, Information Technology, or Business Information Technology with an emphasis in a computer science-related career.
6. Candidates for this scholarship will be of the following ethnic classifications:
 - African American
 - Hispanic
 - Asian American
 - Native American
 - A student of any race that is economically or socially disadvantaged
7. Scholar candidates will be required to be in the top 25% of their class.
8. The minimum cumulative GPA to maintain the scholarship will be 3.0 and a consistent semester performance of 3.0. Transcripts should be sent to Eastman prior to invoice for scholarship payment.
9. Beyond the minimal academic requirements, the selection will focus on the dimensions identified as key behaviors for Eastman.
 - Communication
 - Initiative
 - Technical Skills
 - Leadership
 - Teamwork
 - Judgment
 - Analysis
10. Scholars will be required to work an internship for Eastman prior to their graduation, if positions are offered. Students shall be notified by the Eastman Co-op/Intern Coordinator regarding the upcoming internship openings.
