

The NYC Turing Fellows Program is accepting applications.

NYC Turing Fellowships are awarded annually to top computer science and mathematics students for paid summer internships with leading NYC startups.

Participating companies this year include Etsy, Kickstarter, Squarespace, Knewton, Birchbox, OpenSky and Zocdoc.

The fellowship presents summer internship opportunities for outstanding college students to live and work in New York City, develop their technical skills, benefit from mentorship, and pursue meaningful technology projects in the context of a fast-growing start-up company.

At the completion of the experience each fellow will receive a \$5,000 fellowship check in addition to their paid internship. The 19 fellows in the 2011 class were drawn from over 700 applicants from all of the top computer science programs throughout the country.
